

2017 Board of Directors Ballot & Proxy

As the designated representative of a member company of the Greater Cleveland Partnership (GCP), you are entitled to vote in the election of the GCP Board of Directors. As indicated in the ballot, 22 nominees will be elected to three-year terms that expire in 2020, which includes new Directors and those being re-elected to the GCP Board. There is 1 nominee to be elected to fill an open seat in the class of 2019 and 1 nominee to be elected to fill an open seat in the class of 2018. Pursuant to the Code, candidates have been recommended by a nominating committee and notice was given to the membership inviting additional nominations. No nominations were received from the Members.
